## **Summary of Draft Minutes: April 2025**

Present: Andrew Bingham (AB), Paul Martin (PM), Karen Hobley (KH), Mary Manning (MM), Mary Dowson (MD), Steve Highton (SH), Don Crossman (DC), Angela Thornton (AT) Clerk, and 3 parishioners.

### 1. Minutes of the March meeting approved.

#### 2. Matters Arising

- a) Norfolk CC has contacted the landowner regarding the problem with footpath FP14.
- b) Highways Officer confirmed the drain outside Lovells is on the work schedule.
- c) Highways Officer confirmed the village road markings are on the work schedule.
- d) Taxis using the Play Area car park will be monitored.

### 3. Public Participation

A village sign was requested to be placed on the village green. The village green is owned by the High Bailiffs Trust (HBT) so it was suggested that village opinion was sought, designs and costings sourced and the HBT contacted. If it progresses funding may be available from the PC.

#### 4. District/ County Councillor Report

None.

## 5. Parish Cllr Reports

PM informed the meeting that the water for the allotments has been turned on.

#### 6. Financial Matters

- a) March Bank Reconciliation approved.
- b) Payments for April 2025 approved.
- c) Request water meter reading for allotments bill. Action AT.
- d) Discussion took place following emails explaining the clerical error in the submission of the 2025/6 precept. AT clarified the amount of precept requested from BDC had not deducted -4k income which resulted in an additional 4k precept for this year.

Following legal and audit advice, this money will be held in NBPC bank account and either used for a project during the current financial year or taken account of in the following year's precept.

In future the precept request Form B of the Local Government Finance Act will be countersigned by the Chair of NBPC.

### 7. Planning

No new applications or decisions.

#### 8. Amenities

- a) Grounds Maintenance: AB to contact contractor re 'no mow May'.
- b) Closed Churchyard: AB met with PCC and agreed some tidying of vegetation on South Wall be discussed with BTS.
- c) Cemetery: none.
- d) Allotments: plot 16/17 now let. Permission for 4 dwarf trees. Debris accumulating again, AT to write to tenants with photos.
- e) Play Area: DC to investigate whether the fencing is included in works from safety report.
- f) Community Car Scheme: going well, 2 more drivers would be of benefit.


